Selection of Vice-Chancellor of Kannada University, Hampi

1. The Government of Karnataka invites applications for the selection of Vice-Chancellor of Kannada University, Hampi, Karnataka as per Section 13(2) of Kannada University Act, 1991 from eligible and distinguished Academicians/Professors with following credentials.
 - i. A distinguished academician, with a minimum of ten years' of experience as Professor in a University or ten years' of experience in a reputed research and/or academic administrative organization with proof of having demonstrated academic leadership of the highest level of competence, integrity, morals and institutional commitment;
 - ii. As provided in Section 13(3) and 13(3)(B) of the Kannada University Act, 1991, the Vice-Chancellor shall, subject to the pleasure of the Chancellor, hold the office for a maximum period of 3 years or until he attains the age of Sixty Five years whichever is earlier. Consequently, a person to be appointed as Vice-Chancellor shall have clear three years of tenure.
2. Eligible candidates interested in applying for the post of Vice-Chancellor of Kannada University, may submit application in the UGC prescribed proforma attached herewith by providing details of their qualification, academic, research credentials and administrative experiences, achievements & other details in triplicate within 20 days from the date of publication of this advertisement (including general holidays) to the Principal Secretary to Government, Higher Education Department, 6 Floor, Gate No: 02, M.S. Building, Bangalore-560 001. Envelope containing the application form should be super scribed as "APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF VICE CHANCELLOR, KANNADA UNIVERSITY." One copy of the application in PDF format should be sent electronically to the e-mail: highereducationso1@gmail.com within the prescribed period.
3. Persons currently in service are required to submit an attested certificate from their employer to confirm that no departmental/criminal enquiry are pending/not intended to be initiated against them and not previously initiated

and penalized and that he/she is neither having a tainted service history nor is their appointment in dispute. Retired candidates should file a self attested certificate to this effect. Strict action as per law will be initiated if faulty information is found to be given in the certificates. Applications without this certificate will not be considered for selection.

5. Incomplete applications submitted without relevant documents and applications not made in prescribed proforma and applications received after the stipulated time limit will be rejected. Higher Education department is not responsible for postal or other delays.
